### SR 822/Sheridan Street Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (RRR) Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Virtual Public Meeting for the resurfacing, restoration and rehabilitation (RRR) project on SR 822/ Sheridan Street from N 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to SR 5/US 1/S Federal Highway in the cities of Hollywood and Dania Beach.

Construction Cost: \$893,624

Construction Start: March 29, 2021

Estimated Completion: Fall 2021

### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway
- Making the following median changes:
  - Eliminating an eastbound U-turn at N 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Closing a mid-block opening between N 20<sup>th</sup> Avenue and N 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue
  - Installing an eastbound left-turn at N 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue
- Upgrading pedestrian signals and lighting at N Dixie Highway and N 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue
- Upgrading sidewalks and curb ramps to meet Americans with **Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements**
