Broward Boulevard at NE 3rd Avenue to Undergo Partial Weekend Closure, April 16 & 17

The intersection of Broward Boulevard and NE 3rd Avenue will be partially closed for the removal of existing brick pavers beginning 9:30 p.m., Friday night, April 16, through 2 p.m., Saturday afternoon, April 17. Southbound NE 3rd Avenue traffic will be detoured via eastbound NE 2nd Street, southbound N. Federal Highway, and westbound Broward Boulevard. Northbound SE 3rd Avenue traffic will be detoured via eastbound Broward Boulevard, northbound N. Federal Highway, and westbound NE 4th Street.



PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

Scope of work includes replacing the existing brick pavers with asphalt and upgrading signing and pavement markings at the following intersections: NW/SW 7th Avenue/Avenue of the Arts, N/S Andrews Avenue, NE/SE 3rd Avenue and SR 5/US-1/N Federal Highway, as well as roadway lighting upgrades at the following intersections: NW/SW 7th Avenue/Avenue of the Arts, NW/SW 5th Avenue, NW/SW 1st Avenue, N/S Andrews Avenue and NE/SE 3rd Avenue.
