**SW 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Griffin Road to SW 49<sup>th</sup> Court to Undergo Intermittent Southbound Full Closure through March 28– April 8**  
 Southbound SW 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Griffin Road to SW 49<sup>th</sup> Court will be closed Monday through Friday, **as needed**, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Traffic will be detoured via SW 43<sup>rd</sup> Terrace and SW 49<sup>th</sup> Court.



### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

The City of Dania Beach, as the Project Sponsor, received funding through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and requested that FDOT District Four design and construct the SW 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue Mobility Improvements Project through the City of Dania Beach’s Resolution 2019 –145. Scope of Work includes widening the roadway to accommodate 5-foot bicycle lanes in each direction, providing continuous sidewalks on both sides of the road, installing a bulkhead wall with a traffic railing at Lake George, upgrading vehicle and pedestrian signalization at Griffin Road and milling, resurfacing, and replacing pavement markings.
