

SW 40th Avenue Mobility Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an in-person Construction Open House and Virtual Public Meeting regarding the mobility improvements on SW 40th Avenue in the cities of Dania Beach and Hollywood. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

The City of Dania Beach, as the Project Sponsor, received funding through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and requested that FDOT District Four design and construct the SW 40th Avenue Mobility Improvements Project through the City of Dania Beach Resolution 2019 –145. The Broward MPO is investing over \$300 million to create safer, healthier communities in Broward County and this project is one of many within a larger plan to create enhanced bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access. The Broward MPO is a federally-mandated agency responsible for setting policy on local transportation issues and deciding how to spend Federal and State funding on transportation projects in the Broward region.
