SR 845/POWERLINE ROAD LIGHTING IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information about lighting improvements along SR 845/Powerline Road from SR 810/Hillsboro Boulevard to the Palm Beach County Line in the City of Deerfield Beach.

Construction Cost: \$441,981 Construction Start Date: May 12, 2021 Anticipated Completion: Fall 2021

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Installing 27 new LED light poles along Powerline Road to provide efficient light distribution, save energy and reduce maintenance cost.
- Retrofitting 7 existing lighting poles with LED lights along Powerline Road.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures may occur from 8:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m., Monday through Friday.
- Lane closures at signalized intersections may occur from 11:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Monday through Friday.
- Right turn lanes may be closed as needed.
- Access to businesses and residents will be maintained at all times.

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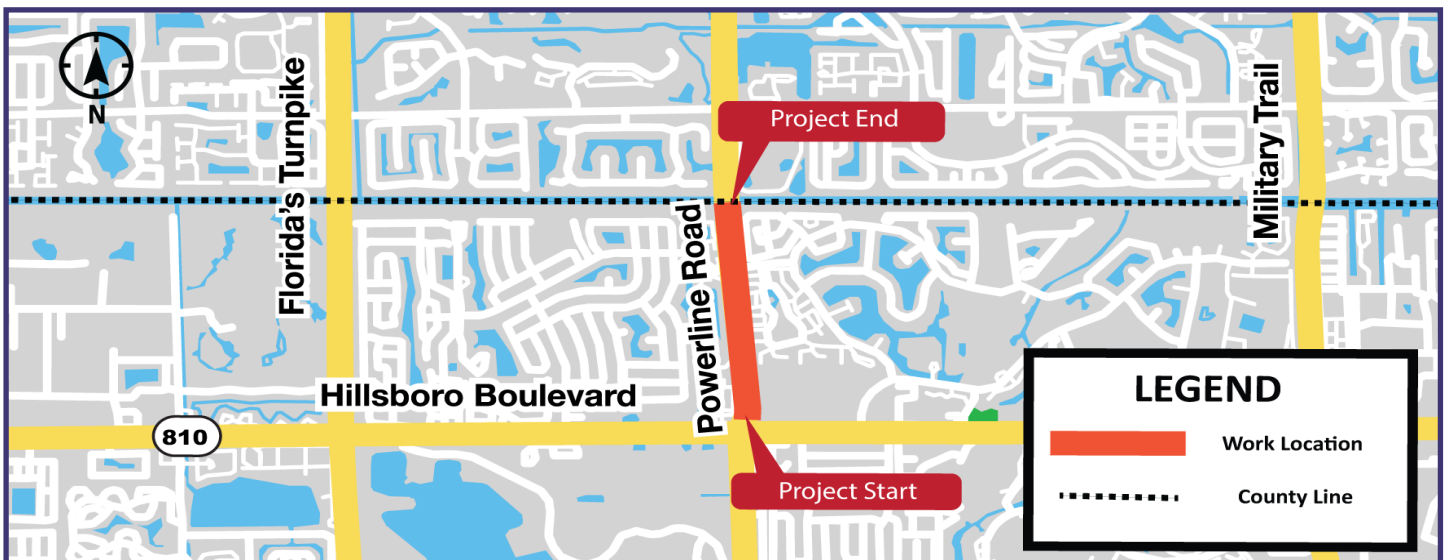
