STATE ROAD 834/SAMPLE ROAD RESURFACING & LIGHTING PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Construction Open House both in-person and virtually regarding roadway and lighting improvements on Sample Road from Military Trail to US 1/Federal Highway in the cities of Deerfield Beach and Pompano Beach. Representatives will be available to provide information and answer questions.

Construction Cost: \$2.7 million Construction Start Date: July 28, 2021 Anticipated Completion: Late 2021

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing of the roadway
- Widening the roadway to increase the turning radii at NW 5th Terrace and NE 3rd Avenue
- Installing nine new light poles
- Retrofitting 21 existing light poles with LED lights
- Upgrading traffic signalization at NW 5th Terrace and NW 5th Avenue
- Upgrading pedestrian signalization at NW 5th Terrace, Dixie Highway, NE 12th Avenue, NE 15th Avenue and US 1/Federal Highway
- Installing high emphasis pavement markings and signing at the Florida East Coast Railroad (FEC) crossing
- Performing minor drainage improvements
- Reconstructing driveways, sidewalks and curb ramps to meet Americans with Disability Act standards
- Improving signing and pavement markings

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Eastbound lane closures may occur west of I-95 at anytime.
- Westbound lane closures may occur west of I-95 7:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., Sunday through Saturday.
- Lane closures may occur east of I-95, 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday.
- Lane closures may occur east of I-95, 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- Access to emergency services, businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.
- Pedestrian detours will be in place during sidewalk closures.
