





Safety and Intersection Improvement Project:

State Road (SR) 822/Sheridan Street at North 46 Avenue





Project Overview

Proposed Improvements:

- Replace existing signalization strain pole system with mast arms
- Upgrade lighting at the intersection with Light Emitting Diode (LED) fixtures
- Extend the eastbound, westbound and northbound left-turn lanes to provide additional vehicle storage
- Repaving the existing roadway
- Replacing and upgrading existing curb ramps to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings
- Upgrading pedestrian signals and push buttons



Temporary Traffic Control Plan

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the inconvenience to the community
- Lane closures, and detours will occur during non-peak hours to minimize impacts on traffic
- Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained at all times during construction

Estimated Construction Cost: \$830,000






