SR 817/University Drive in Miramar Mobility Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Virtual Public Meeting and in-person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming mobility improvements along SR 817/University Drive in the City of Miramar. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

The City of Miramar, as the Project Sponsor, received funding through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and requested that FDOT District Four design and construct the SR 817/University Drive in Miramar Mobility Improvements Project through the City of Miramar's Resolution No. 19-131. The Broward MPO is investing over \$300 million to create safer, healthier communities in Broward County and this project is one of many within a larger plan to create enhanced bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access. The Broward MPO is a federally-mandated agency responsible for setting policy on local transportation issues and decides how to spend federal and state funding on transportation projects in the Broward region. Construction Cost: \$11,281,680 Construction Start: August 2022 Estimated Completion: Early 2024

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Installing curb, gutter, and sidewalks
- Upgrading curb ramps, signing and pavement markings
- Constructing bus shelters at existing bus stop locations
- Adding a new pedestrian overpass bridge near the intersection of Miramar Boulevard, over the South Broward Drainage District (SBDD) Canal No. 1
- Upgrading pedestrian signals with countdown timers at the intersections of:
 - SR 817/University Drive and Miramar Parkway
 - SR 817/University Drive and Miramar Boulevard
 - SR 817/University Drive and Pembroke Road
- Replacing light poles, and adding pedestrian lighting at the intersections of:
 - SR 817/University Drive and Riviera Boulevard
 - SR 817/University Drive and Miramar Parkway
 - SR 817/University Drive and Miramar Boulevard
 - SR 817/University Drive and Pembroke Road

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures are permitted weekdays, between 8:30 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Double lane closures are permitted weekdays between, 11:30 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Business, residential, and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
