## NE 23RD AVENUE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, will replace the NE 23rd Avenue Bridge between NE 29th Street and NE 30th Street in the City of Lighthouse Point.

### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Replacing the existing two-lane bridge over the Ibis Waterway.
- Installing a safety barrier to separate the 6-foot sidewalk on the west side of the bridge.
- Installing irrigation, concrete sidewalks, driveways, signage and pavement markings.

### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

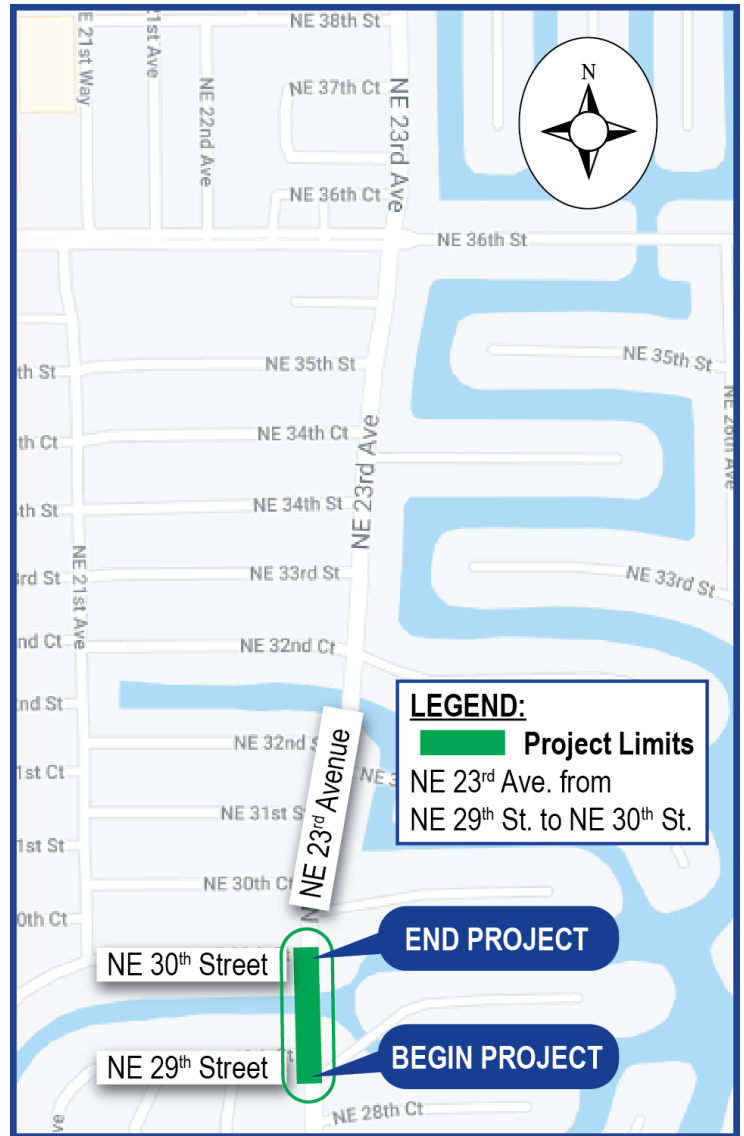
- Full road closure will be needed for the duration of construction along NE 23rd Avenue between NE 29th Street and NE 30th Street.
- Detours will be implemented during construction to maintain access throughout the neighborhood.
- Work will be performed Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Access to residences will be maintained at all times.
