### SW 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue Mobility Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four will host an in-person Construction Open House and Virtual Public Meeting regarding the mobility improvements on SW 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue in the cities of Dania Beach and Hollywood. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

The City of Dania Beach, as the Project Sponsor, received funding through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and requested that FDOT District Four design and construct the SW 40<sup>th</sup> Avenue Mobility Improvements Project through the City of Dania Beach's Resolution 2019-145. The Broward MPO is investing over \$300 million to create safer, healthier communities in Broward County and this project is one of many within a larger plan to create enhanced bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access. The Broward MPO is a federally-mandated agency responsible for setting policy on local transportation issues and deciding how to spend Federal and State funding on transportation projects in the Broward region. **Construction Cost:** \$3,377,160

**Construction Start:** August 6, 2021

**Estimated Completion:** Spring 2023

### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widening the roadway to accommodate 5-foot bicycle lanes in each direction
- Providing continuous sidewalks on both sides of the road
- Installing a bulkhead wall with a traffic railing at Lake George
- Upgrading vehicle and pedestrian signalization at Griffin Road
- Milling, resurfacing, and replacing pavement markings

### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures are permitted weekdays between 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., and weekends between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- Pedestrian access and access to properties will be maintained at all times.
- Additional information about lane closures and detour information will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.

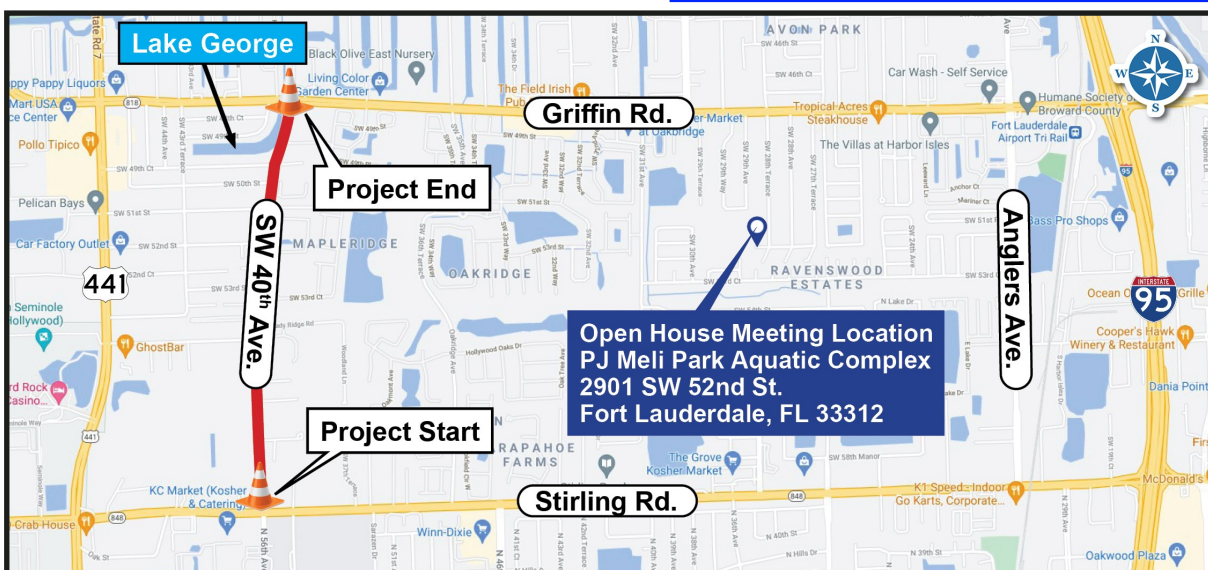
