SR 84 OVER THE SOUTH FORK OF THE NEW RIVER BRIDGE PAINTING PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information regarding routine maintenance of the SR 84 bridge over the South Fork of the New River in the Cities of Fort Lauderdale, Hollywood, Dania Beach, and the Town of Davie.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

 Painting the steel portions of the fourlane bascule bridge (Bridge No. 860008) over the South Fork of the New River

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single-lane closures may occur between 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- Full bridge closures may occur for a maximum of 64 nights between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.
- Traffic will be detoured in both directions during bridge closures to:
 - * SR 7/US 441
 - * Griffin Road
 - * SW 30th Avenue
 - * Alternate Detour: SW 36th Street and SW 26th Terrace
- Access to adjacent businesses will be maintained during the closures.
- Marine traffic will be maintained through the navigable waterway. Bridge openings will occur on demand and require 24-hour notice. Channel restrictions may occur.
