EASTBOUND SR A1A/ SE 17TH STREET CAUSEWAY BRIDGE TO CLOSE NIGHTLY, SEPT. 5 — 7

As part of the SR A1A/ SE 17th Street Causeway Bridge Painting project, the eastbound SR A1A/ SE 17th Street Causeway bridge will be closed to traffic and pedestrians nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 7 a.m., Tuesday, Sept. 5 through Thursday, Sept. 7 for bridge rehabilitation and painting operations. Traffic will be detoured via U-turn at Eisenhower Boulevard, westbound SE 17th Street Causeway, northbound SE 3rd Avenue, and eastbound Las Olas Boulevard to SR A1A/Seabreeze Boulevard. Pedestrians will be detoured via Eisenhower Boulevard to the westbound bridge. Signage will be in place to advise the public.



This project includes a full removal of the existing bridge paint and repainting of all steel bridge components, and cleaning and coating of the movable span piers, traffic and pedestrian concrete railing, and control house.
