BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

East Las Olas Boulevard over the Intracoastal Waterway
Broward County, Florida

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will conduct a public meeting for the above referenced project within Broward County. This public meeting will be offered in-person and virtually simultaneously. The public meeting will have representatives available to answer questions. Project information will be available for public viewing. Questions and comments may be submitted prior to the meeting by contacting the Project Manager. PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The purpose of the project is to rehabilitate and extend the service life of the existing bridge. This will increase the resiliency of our infrastructure and promote the movement of goods and people.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

Scope of Work:

- Replace old deck with new solid surface aluminum deck
- Paint the movable bridge deck and fascia elements
- Replace important electrical components and wiring
- Replace the mechanical span locks which connect the two halves of the movable bridge deck when the bridge is in the “down” position
- Replace the existing navigation/marine fenders in the waterway, including replacement of the timber piles and support beams
- Renovate the bridge tender house
- Minor repaving of the roadway at ends of the bridge and restore traffic monitoring site

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Work will be done in phases to minimize impacts to the community
- Full and partial bridge closures will occur during phases for the fender construction and deck replacement, respectively; and detours will be provided utilizing Sunrise Boulevard, SR 5/US-1, and SR A1A
- Full bridge closures will occur during non-peak (i.e., nighttime) hours, and will not occur during major special events
- Each phase requiring a full (nighttime only) or partial bridge closure is expected to be one month or less
- Temporary lane closures will be required for some phases (such as bridge painting, and minor repaving) and will occur during non-peak hours
- Pedestrian traffic will be maintained on the side of the bridge opposite from any ongoing construction
- Access to properties on both sides of the bridge will be maintained during construction

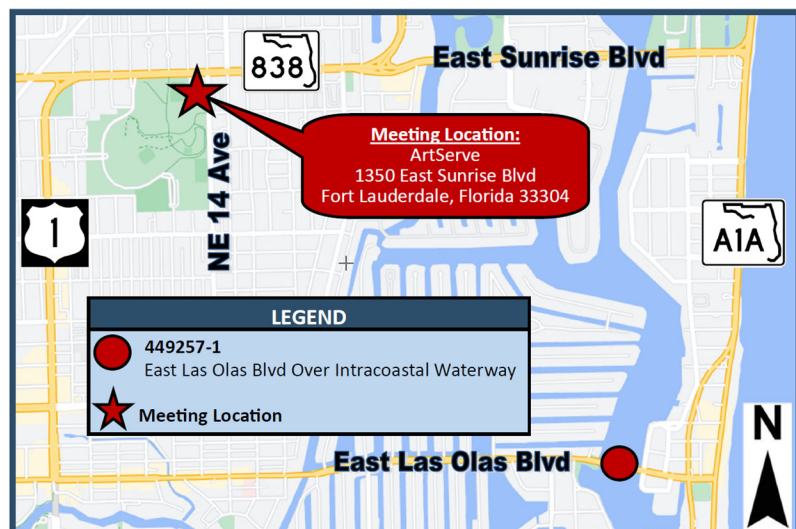
