SR 844/14TH STREET CAUSEWAY OVER THE INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY BRIDGE CLOSURE

SR 844/14th Street Causeway over the Intracoastal Waterway will be closed to vehicle and pedestrian traffic from 11 p.m. Friday, Nov. 12, to 8 a.m. Monday, Nov. 15, and from 11 p.m. Friday, Nov. 19, to 8 a.m. Monday, Nov. 22, for work on the bridge's mechanical components. Traffic will be detoured to SR 814/Atlantic Boulevard and SR 810/ Hillsboro Boulevard (see detour map below). Access to adjacent properties on 14th Street Causeway will be maintained on either side of the bridge.

Construction Cost: \$1,068,288 Construction Start Date: October 25, 2021 Anticipated Completion: Spring 2022

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- Painting the steel and concrete portions of the SR 844/14th Street Causeway bascule bridge (Bridge No. 860060) over the Intracoastal Waterway in the city of Pompano Beach
- Refurbishing the span locks and other mechanical components of the bridge

MARINE IMPACTS

- The navigable waterway under the 14th Street Causeway bridge will be limited to half channel navigation from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily through January 31, 2022. Full channel openings may be requested two hours in advance by calling (954) 942-6909.
- The vertical clearance at the navigable channel will be reduced by 3 feet.
- The schedule of channel restrictions is published in the U.S. Coast Guard's Local Notice to Mariners at <u>www.navcen.uscg.gov</u>.


