Lauderdale Lakes Greenway is a part of a U.S. Department of Transportation – Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) Grant, awarded to the Broward MPO and its local city partners to enhance continuity and extend the Broward Regional Complete Street network. The Broward MPO is investing over \$300 million to create safer, healthier communities in Broward. This project is one of many within a larger plan to create enhanced bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access throughout the Broward region. PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Constructing a 10-foot shared-use path along NW 39th Street to connect to the existing greenway
- Installing decorative pedestrian lighting to increase visibility
- Installing irrigation and landscaping

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- No lane closures are expected for this project.
- Business signage will be provided to identify driveways.
- Access to businesses and residents will be maintained at all times.
