## **Bass Creek Road Mobility Improvements Project**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information for the Bass Creek Road Mobility Improvements Project in the City of Miramar. The City of Miramar, as the Project Sponsor, received funding through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and requested that FDOT District Four design and construct the Bass Creek Road Roundabout Improvements Project through the City of Miramar Resolution No. 16-01.

The Broward MPO is investing over \$300 million to create safer, healthier communities in Broward County and this project is one of many within a larger plan to create enhanced bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access. The Broward MPO is a federally-mandated agency responsible for setting policy on local transportation issues and decided how to spend federal and state funding on transportation projects in the Broward region. Construction Cost: \$1,967,721

Construction Start: late–July 2022

Estimated Completion: Early 2023

### **PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS**

- Constructing a roundabout at the intersection of SW 148th Avenue and Bass Creek Road
- Constructing a shared-use path on the east side of SW 148th Avenue within the project limits
- Milling and resurfacing SW 148th Avenue within the project limits
- Minor roadway widening along SW 148th Avenue
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings
- Installing new light poles

### **TRAFFIC IMPACTS**

- Lane closures are permitted from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- Access to schools, businesses, pedestrians, and residences will be maintained at all times.
