SR A1A BRIDGE PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Construction Open House both in person and virtually regarding the erosion prevention of the State Road A1A Bridge over the Hillsboro Inlet in the City of Pompano Beach. Participants may attend in person or online. Representatives will be available to provide information and answer questions. Project documents will be available at the meeting and available for download from the virtual meeting platform.

Construction Cost: \$1.8 million Construction Start Date: November 18, 2021 Anticipated Completion: Spring 2022

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Installing articulated concrete blocks (ACB) for scour prevention within the navigable channel and bridge foundation.
- Removing and replacing the existing bicycle plates
- Removing and replacing the underwater cabling system.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures in each direction may occur at anytime, Monday through Friday.
- Full closures may occur along North Riverside Drive at anytime, Monday through Friday. Detour route will be implemented as needed.
- Pedestrian traffic will not be impacted.
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.

MARINE TRAFFIC IMPACTS

 Half-Channel closures can be expected for sediment containment, during construction operations. Access will be maintained at all times.


