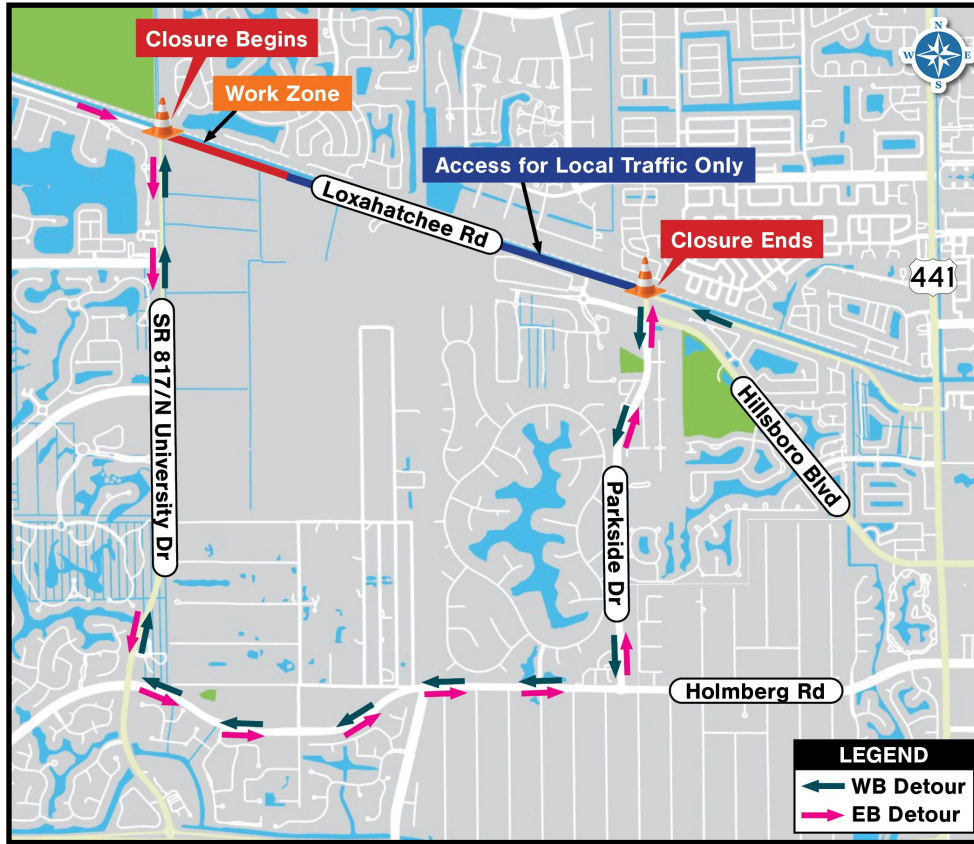

LOXAHATCHEE ROAD TO UNDERGO FULL CLOSURE BEGINNING MONDAY, OCT. 30

Loxahatchee Road from SR 817/N University Drive to Parkside Drive will be closed around-the-clock beginning at 11 a.m., Monday, Oct. 30 until Fall 2024. Traffic will be detoured via SR 817/N University Drive, Holmberg Road, and Parkside Drive. Access to local roads and residential properties between the work zone and Parkside Drive will be maintained.



Construction Cost: \$33,480,584

Construction Start Date: October 30, 2023

Anticipated Completion: Late 2026

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

The project improvements consist of widening the road to accommodate bike lanes, creating a continuous sidewalk on the south side of the road, constructing roundabouts at Nob Hill Road, University Drive, and Parkside Drive, adding an additional eastbound left turn lane onto SR 7/US 441, milling and resurfacing the roadway, and upgrading signage and pavement markings.
