## I-95 Northbound Lanes at SR-84/Marina Mile Boulevard to Close Dec. 11–14

I-95 northbound lanes at SR-84/Marina Mile Boulevard will be closed to traffic overnight Sunday night, Dec. 11 through Wednesday night, Dec. 14 for overhead sign structure installation. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 10 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 11:30 p.m., reopening by 5:30 a.m. I-95 northbound traffic will via the I-595 eastbound exit ramp, US-1 and SR-736/Davie Boulevard. SR-84/Marina Mile Boulevard traffic will be detoured west to SR-7/US-441 and SR-736/Davie Boulevard. Thursday night, Dec. 15 will be used as contingency if needed. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.



This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes north from just south of Broward Boulevard to just north of Commercial Boulevard in Broward County, to include two Managed Lanes in each direction. Scope of work includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes, ramp reconstructions, bridge widenings, ramp signalization, installation of noise barrier walls along I-95 northbound and southbound, guardrail, barrier wall, drainage, landscape relocation, and ITS installation.
