

State Road (SR) 848/Stirling Road at SR 9/I-95 To Undergo Full Nightly Closures October — April 2024

As part of 95 Express Lanes Phase 3C, all lanes of State Road (SR) 848/Stirling Road at SR 9/I-95 will be closed overnight, as needed, 11 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., through Friday, April 26, for bridge construction operations. Once the closure is implemented, westbound traffic will be detoured via Oakwood Boulevard, Sheridan Street, and N 29th Avenue. Eastbound traffic will be detoured via N 29th Avenue, Sheridan Street and Oakwood Boulevard. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

*Please note, full closures will not take place over the Thanksgiving or Christmas/New Year's holidays.



This project will extend the existing Express Lanes north from just south of Hollywood Boulevard to just south of Broward Boulevard in Broward County. One lane will be added and the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane will be converted to create two Express Lanes in each direction. The number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Other project improvements include construction of I-95/I-595 Direct Connectors between 95 Express Lanes and I-595, as well as reconstruction, milling, resurfacing, and widening of I-595 from SR 7 to I-95 and along I-95 from south of Hollywood Boulevard to south of Broward Boulevard. Additional work includes bridge widening along I-95 at several locations, painting of 17 bridges within project limits, I-95/SR 84 interchange modifications, Integrated Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Installation, including traffic monitoring devices, detectors, and dynamic message signs to optimize traffic operations, tolling/gantry construction, ramp signalization implementation at the interchanges, lighting, signage, and drainage installation and construction of shoulder—mounted sound walls and retaining walls.
