Daily Full Closures Beginning Monday, January 4, 2021

North 56th Avenue from Sheridan Street to Stirling Road will be closed daily, Monday through Friday, between 9 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. for roadway widening to accommodate 7-foot buffered bicycle lanes. Traffic will be detoured through US 441/ SR 7. Access will be maintained for school drop-off and pick-up, local residents, public transportation, and emergency responders.


