SR 817/UNIVERSITY DRIVE MOBILITY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Construction Open House both in person and virtually regarding mobility improvements for SR 817/University Drive in the City of Coral Springs. Participants may attend in person or online. Representatives will be available to provide information and answer questions. Project documents will be available at the meeting and available for download from the virtual meeting platform.

The City of Coral Springs, as the Project Sponsor, requested through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) that FDOT, District Four, design and construct the University Drive Mobility Improvement Project. The Broward MPO is investing over \$300 million to create safer, healthier communities in Broward County. This project is one of many within a larger plan to create enhanced bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access throughout the Broward region. Construction Cost: \$3.5 million **Construction Start: January 10, 2022** **Completion: Fall 2022**

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widening southbound SR 817/University Drive from NW 32nd Street to SR 834/Sample Road to construct a bus bay and implement a dedicated right-turn lane at NW 32nd Street
- Upgrading northbound pavement markings to designate 4-foot bicycle lanes between NW 28th Street and NW 31st Court and 7-foot bicycle lanes between NW 31st Court to Sample Road
- Upgrading southbound pavement markings to designate 7-foot bicycle lanes from Sample Road to NW 32nd Street and 4-foot bicycle lanes from NW 32nd Street to NW 28th Street
- Upgrading traffic and pedestrian signals at the following intersections:
NW 28th Street, NW 31st Court and SR 834/Sample Road
- Installing 11 light poles along the project corridor
- Upgrading drainage, and signage
- Milling and resurfacing along the project corridor

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures may occur in each direction, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday.
- Lane closures may occur in each direction, 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.
