



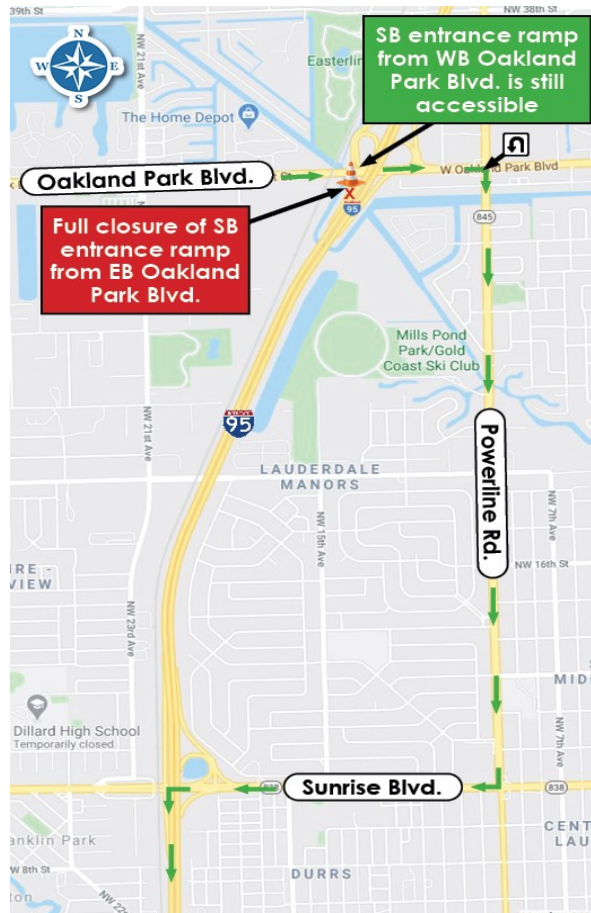

### I-95 SB Entrance Ramp from EB Oakland Park Blvd. To Undergo Full Weekend Closure Jan. 22—25

The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Oakland Park Boulevard will undergo a full weekend closure for full depth roadway reconstruction, beginning 10 p.m., Friday night, Jan. 22 through 5 a.m., Monday morning, Jan. 25. During this closure, motorists can access the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Oakland Park Boulevard via a U-Turn or continue to I-95 southbound via Powerline Road and Sunrise Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.



This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes north from just south of Broward Boulevard to just north of Commercial Boulevard in Broward County, to include two Managed Lanes in each direction. Scope of work includes widening and converting the existing I-95 HOV Lanes to Managed Lanes, ramp reconstructions, bridge widenings, ramp signalization, installation of noise barrier walls along I-95 northbound and southbound, guardrail, barrier wall, drainage, landscape relocation, and ITS installation.
