SR 5/ US1 DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN PALM BEACH GARDENS PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING SCHEDULED

PALM BEACH GARDENS – There will be a public meeting scheduled for the S.R. 5/ U.S. 1 drainage improvement project in Palm Beach Gardens on Wednesday, December 17, Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Officials report.

The public meeting is being held to inform the local community in the Palm Beach Gardens and northern Palm Beach County area about the upcoming drainage improvement project. Representatives from FDOT and TBE Group will be available to answer questions about the upcoming construction on S.R. 5/U.S. 1 at the intersection of S.R. A1A/PGA Boulevard. This informal meeting will be held at the project field office at 11641 Kew Gardens Avenue, Suite 101, Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33410, 8 a.m. until 5 p.m.

This 0.18 mile drainage improvement project will begin on January 5, 2009. This project includes installing new storm water drainage outside the roadway, repaving, utility work and the installation of french drainage. There will be several lane closures and traffic shift throughout the project.
