This June, contractors for the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will begin the I-95 Expansion Projects (*Financial Identification Numbers 406870-1-52-01, 406870-2-52-01 and 413843-1-52-0*) along I-95 between PGA Boulevard and S.R. 706/Indiantown Road, including improvements on S.R. 706/Indiantown Road from the Florida Turnpike to Chasewood Plaza. These projects include widening I-95 to provide High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes in each direction and are the last of several related projects designed to ease congestion along I-95 in Palm Beach County.

**As part of our commitment to informing the public about construction projects that will benefit their community, the Department will host a Public Meeting on Wednesday, June 4, 2008, between the hours of 5 p.m. and 7 p.m. The meeting will be held at the project's public information field office at 11641 Kew Gardens Avenue, Suite 101, in Palm Beach Gardens.**

Attendees will have an opportunity to review project plans, ask questions and speak with project representatives about the scope of work and anticipated construction schedule. If special assistance is required, please contact the number below, before Wednesday, May 28, 2008.
