EASTBOUND PGA BOULEVARD AT I-95 to be CLOSED NIGHTLY JUNE 4 and JUNE 5

PALM BEACH GARDENS – Eastbound travel lanes on PGA Boulevard approaching I-95 will be closed, 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., the nights of, June 4 and June 5, Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Officials report.

Eastbound PGA Boulevard east of Military TrailI-95 will be closed. Eastbound traffic will be detoured northbound on Military Trail, eastbound to Kyoto Gardens Drive, southbound onto Alternate A1A and onto eastbound PGA Boulevard. The Southbound I-95 exit ramp onto eastbound PGA Boulevard will be closed. Motorists will be required to exit onto westbound Military Trail and follow the detour route. Only one westbound travel lane will remain open in this area.

Delays are to be expected. Electronic message boards will provide advance warning to motorists. The detour route will be clearly marked with appropriate signage. This closure is being performed in conjunction with the I-95 HOV Expansion Project.

This \$44 million, 4.3 mile construction project will expand the existing six-lane interstate to 10-lane highway which includes one general purpose lane and one High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane in each direction and additional auxiliary lanes. The project includes mainline ramp reconstruction and the widening of the existing bridges over PGA Boulevard and Military Trail. Additional enhancements include improved drainage; sound barrier and retaining wall construction; new signing, pavement marking, lighting, and landscaping. Construction began August 20, 2008 and is being performed by Community Asphalt Corporation. This project is expected to be completed winter 2011.
