The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information for the I-95 Milling and Resurfacing Project from north of Gateway Boulevard to Lantana Road in Palm Beach County.

Construction Cost: \$11.9 million Construction Start: January 4, 2021 Anticipated Completion: Spring 2022

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

Work includes milling and resurfacing I-95 in both directions as well as the entrance and exit ramps at Hypoluxo Road and Lantana Road. This project also includes median lighting upgrades.

TRAFFIC IMPACT

- Lane closures on I-95 are permitted nightly, 9:30 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. One lane of I-95 may close at 9:30 p.m., two lanes may close at 11:00 p.m. and three lanes may close 1:00 a.m. until 5:00 a.m. All lanes will reopen by 6:00 a.m.
- Full ramp closures are permitted nightly, 9:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- Full ramp closures will be required for paving operations; advanced notice and detour information will be provided prior to any closures.

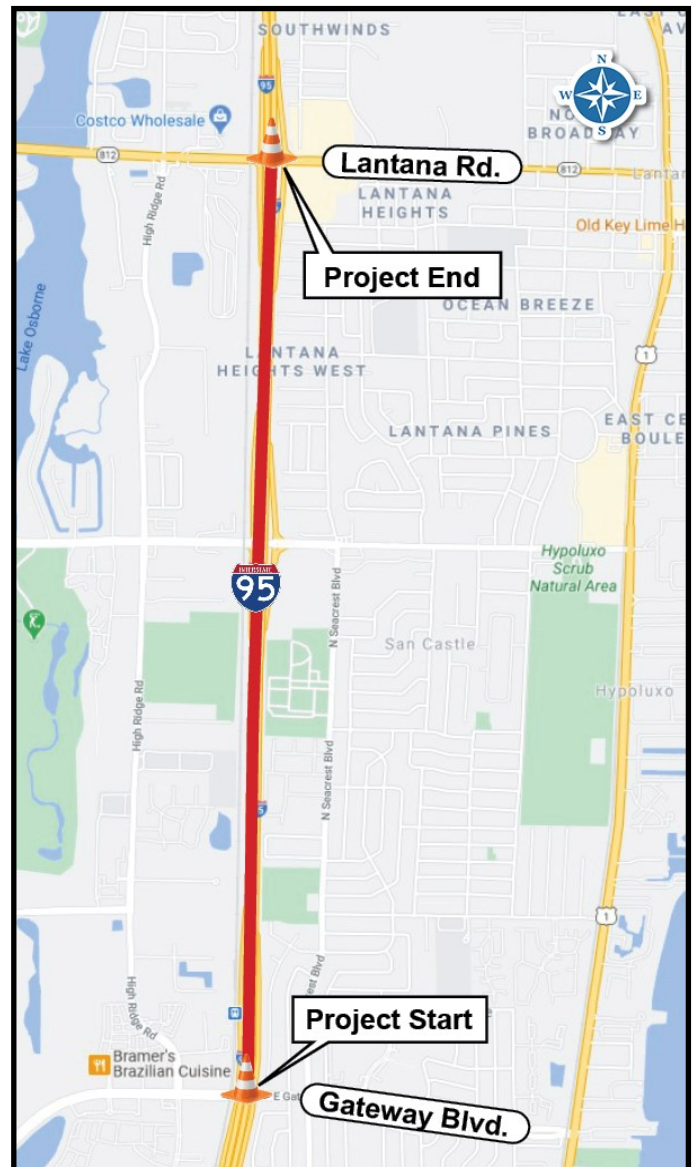
