STEEPLECHASE DRIVE AT S.R. 710/BEELINE HIGHWAY TO CLOSE OCT. 20 - NOV. 10, 2025

- Beginning Monday, Oct. 20, through Monday, Nov. 10, Steeplechase Drive at S.R. 710/Beeline Highway will be closed around -the-clock for roadway reconstruction.
- Motorists traveling northwest on S.R. 710/Beeline Highway approaching the Steeplechase Community entrance will be detoured to North Jog Road, and east on Northlake Boulevard to Steeplechase Drive to enter the community.
- Motorists exiting the Steeplechase Community will be detoured west onto Northlake Boulevard, south onto North Jog Road, and southeast onto S.R. 710/Beeline Highway.
- Flaggers will be on-site, and signage will be posted along the detour route and within the Steeplechase Community to assist motorists.
