SR-710/Beeline Highway Resurfacing and Restoration Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information for the SR-710/Beeline Highway resurfacing and restoration project in Palm Beach County.

Construction Cost: \$3.2 million Construction Start: February 2023 Estimated Completion: Summer 2023

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing existing travel lanes and shoulders
- Upgrading pavement markings and signing to current standards
- Installing internally illuminated street name signs at signalized intersections
- Upgrading existing street lighting to Light Emitting Diode (LED) luminaires.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Construction will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public.
- One lane may be closed in each direction on CR-711/Pratt Whitney Road/Innovation Drive, daily, 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday through Sunday.
- One lane and shoulder will be closed around the clock in each direction on SR-710/Beeline Highway.
- Flaggers will be on site to direct traffic through the work zone during traffic shifts at the CSX Railroad crossing.
- Access to businesses will be maintained at all times.
