SR A1A/BLUE HERON BOULEVARD BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Construction Open House both in person and virtually regarding upcoming improvements to the Blue Heron Boulevard Bridge over the Intracoastal Waterway in the City of Riviera Beach. Participants may attend in person or online. Representatives will be available to provide information and answer questions.

Construction Cost: \$4.4 million

Construction Start: March 2023

Anticipated Completion: Late 2023

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Replacing portions of the bridge deck in the outside westbound lane
- Repairing concrete on the bridge foundations, including the bridge piers, columns and beams
- Milling and resurfacing the roadway at each end of the bridge
- Adding new pavement markings

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- During the deck replacement, there will be one lane of traffic in each direction.
- Before and after the deck replacement, single lane closures may occur 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Sunday through Saturday and 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.
- Full closure of the eastbound lanes may occur 9:00 p.m. Monday through 7:00 a.m. Saturday with traffic detoured to SR 786/PGA Boulevard via SR 5/US 1. Westbound and eastbound lanes will not be closed simultaneously.
- Phil Foster Park will remain open while the beach area under the bridge will be closed during the deck replacement.
- Pedestrian detours will be in place during sidewalk closures.
- Marine traffic will be maintained while some restrictions to the navigational waterway may occur.
- Access to adjacent properties will be maintained.

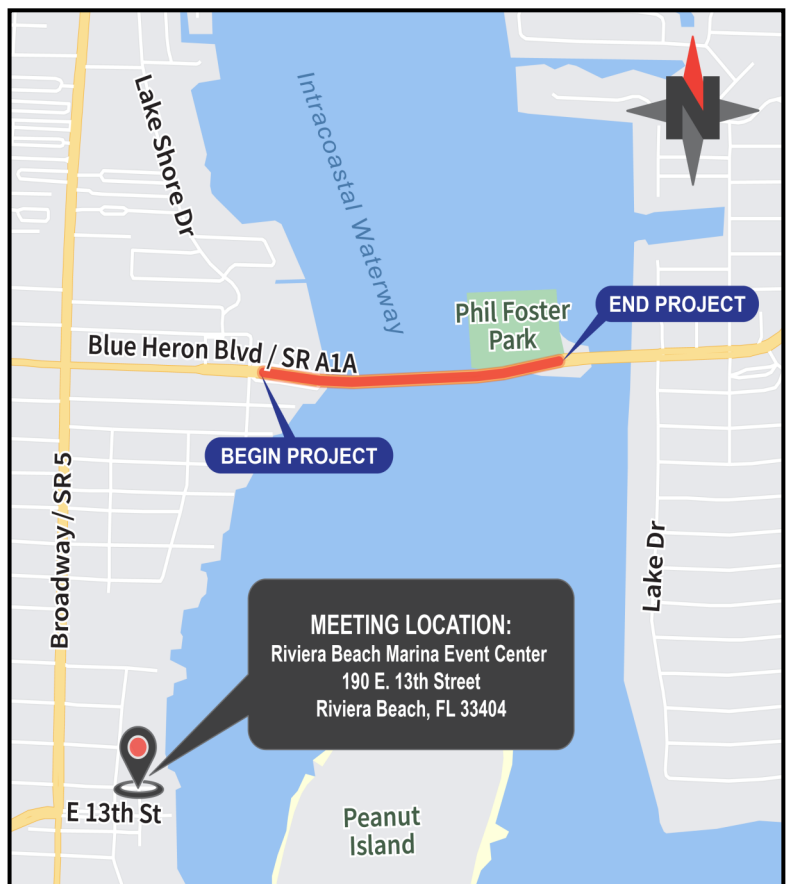
