**Full Closure of SR 700/Conners Highway for Road Construction Work, May 1 – September 30, 2024**

## ROAD CONSTRUCTION WORK ON SR 700/CONNERS HIGHWAY FROM HATTON HIGHWAY TO SR 80/US 441

- **Beginning at 12:01 a.m. Wednesday, May 1, 2024, SR 700/Conners Highway from Hatton Highway to SR 80/US 441, will be closed around-the-clock through approximately 5 p.m. Monday, September 30, 2024, for road construction work.**
- Northbound SR 700/Conners Highway will be detoured to SR 80/US 441 to Hatton Highway.
- Southbound SR 700/Conners Highway will be detoured to Hatton Highway to SR 80/US 441.
- Emergency/First Responder access and local access will be maintained and coordinated.

## PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing of SR 700/Conners Highway.
- Replacing and upgrading existing curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
- Installing rumble strips for the roadway segment with posted speed greater than 50 miles per hour (mph).
- Minor shoulder widening in various locations.
- Installing, upgrading and repairing guardrail as needed
- Upgrading pedestrian signals, pavement markings and signs.

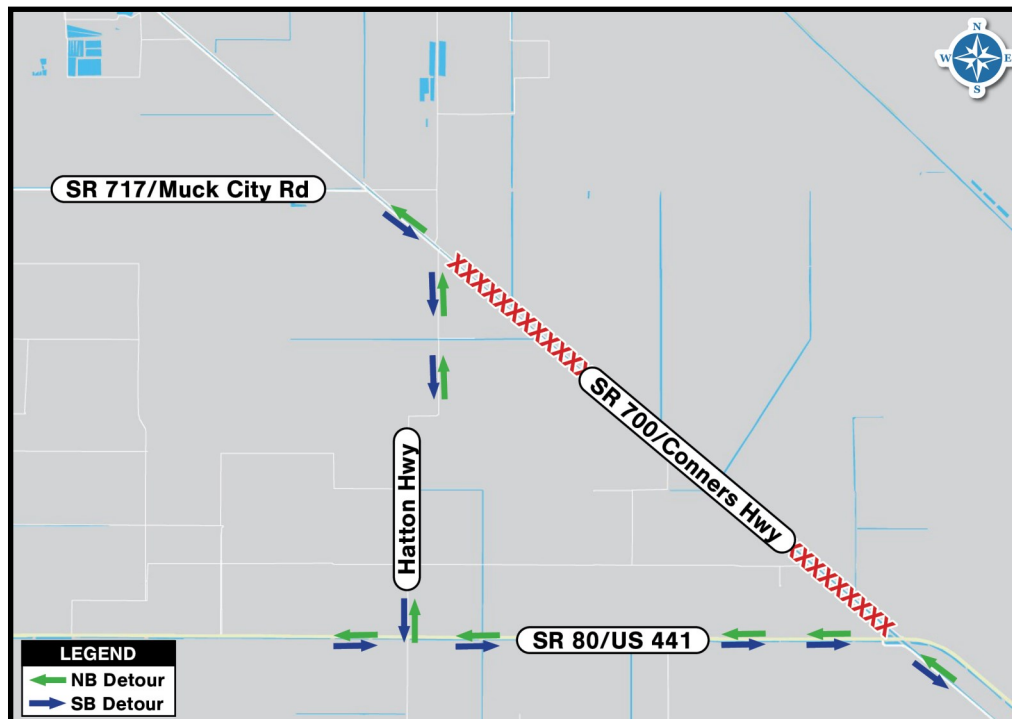
