SR 25/US 27 Resurfacing and Restoration Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information for the State Road 25/US 27 resurfacing and restoration project in Palm Beach County.

Construction Cost: \$18 Million

Construction Start: May 5, 2022

Estimated Completion: Early 2024

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing existing travel lanes and shoulders including shoulder widening
- Replacing or resetting guardrails along the roadway
- Restoring sidewalk at various locations and upgrading curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Adding pedestrian gates at the FEC Railroad crossing
- Improving lighting and replacing the signals at SR 80/East Palm Beach Road
- Upgrading pedestrian signals, pavement markings, and signing to current standards
- Installing rumble strips and internally illuminated retroreflective pavement markings

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Construction will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public
- One lane and the shoulder may be closed in either direction, Monday through Sunday; however, continuous lane closures will not exceed 3 miles
- Access to businesses, residences, driveways, and bus stops will be maintained at all times; pedestrian detours will be clearly marked
- Access to local sugar and farming operations will be provided at all times during season
- The posted speed limit will be reduced 10 mph in the active work zones

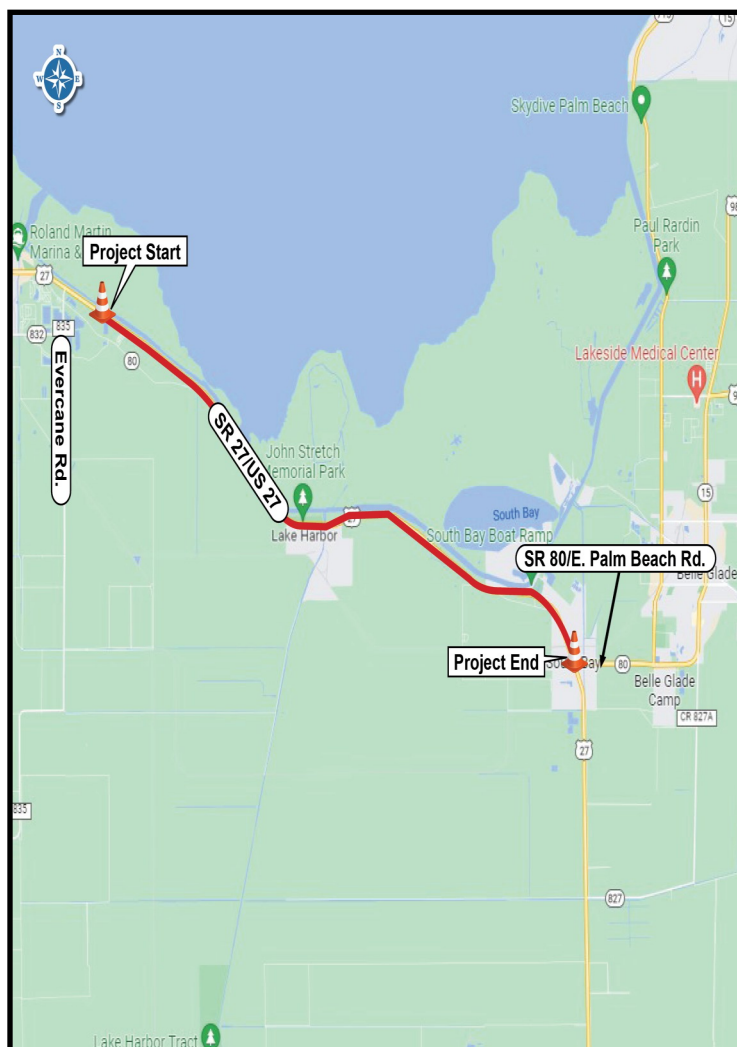
