### SR A1A Gravity Wall Replacement Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four will host a Virtual Public Meeting on Tuesday, June 7, 2022, from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. The In-Person Construction Open House will be held on Thursday, June 9, 2022, from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

**Construction Cost:** \$2.3 Million

**Construction Start:** June 27, 2022

**Estimated Completion:** Early 2023

### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Replace existing gravity wall with a steel sheet pile wall, which will extend the service life of the wall
- Replace sidewalk, curb and gutter, and fencing
- Mill and resurface the roadway
- Upgrade pavement markings and signing to latest standards

### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Construction will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public
- The regulatory speed limit will be reduced from 45 mph to 35 mph within the project limits
- Pedestrian access will be maintained throughout construction
- No impacts on John D. MacArthur State Park are anticipated
- Lane closures are permitted Monday through Friday, 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. Two-way traffic will be maintained by a flagging operation.
- A full roadway closure will be required nightly, Sunday through Thursday from 9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. for milling, resurfacing and pavement markings; advanced notice will be provided with motorist and pedestrian detours clearly marked.

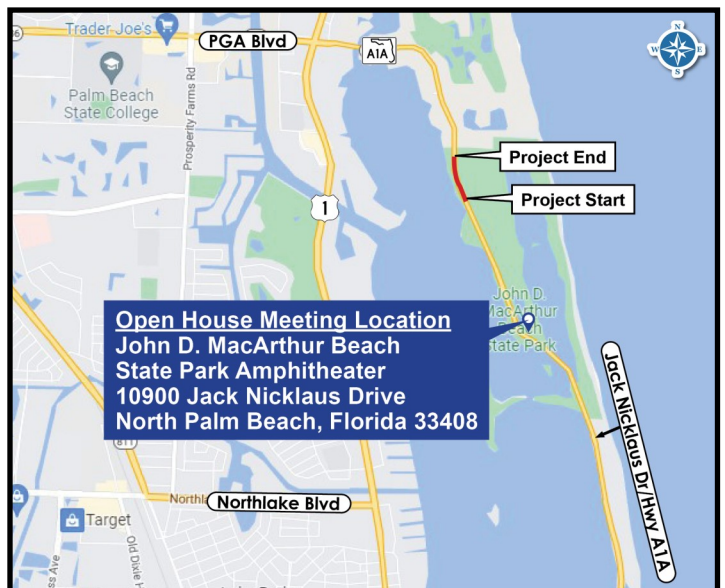
- **The park entry fee will be waived upon letting the Park Ranger know you are there for the Construction Open House.**
