#### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling & resurfacing the roadway and guardrail installation
- Upgrading curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Improvements to intersection street lighting, pedestrian signalization, signage and pavement markings
