PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

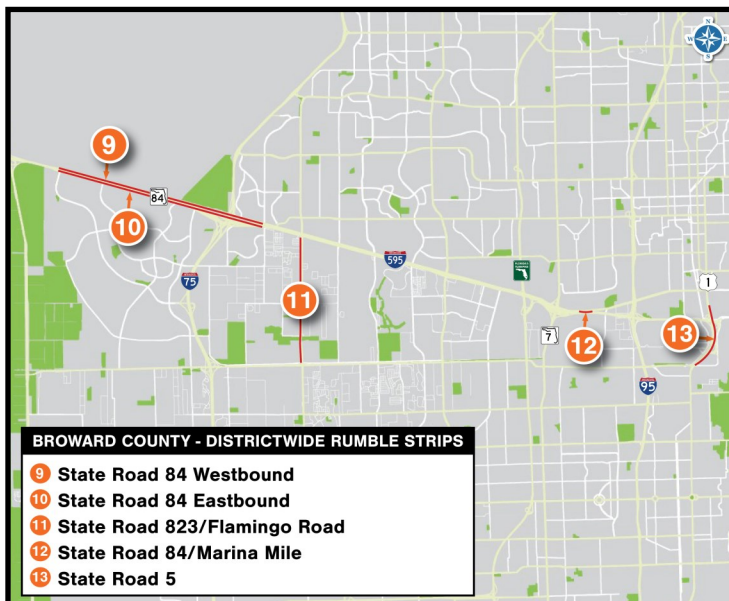
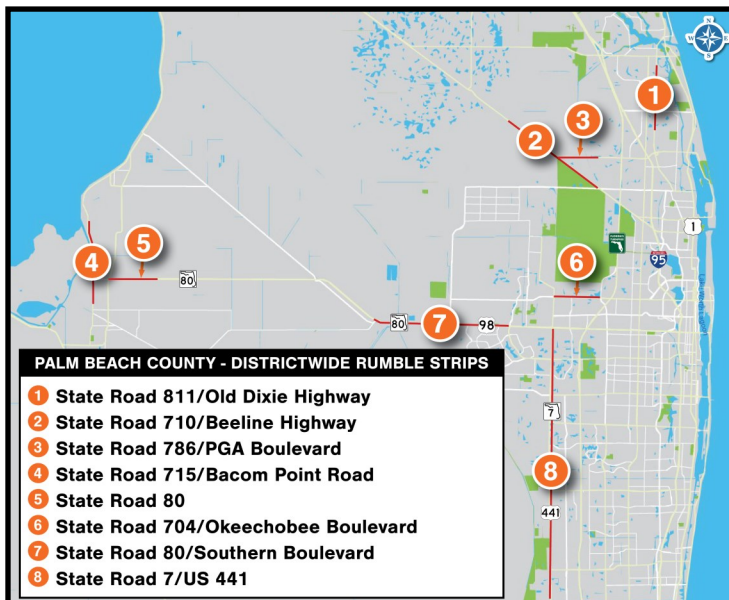
Adding rumble strips and replacing pavement markings to enhance safety in 13 different roadway corridors within Palm Beach and Broward Counties. Locations are not listed in terms of start dates which will vary.

Palm Beach County

- State Road (SR) 811/Old Dixie Highway from Palm Beach Gardens to Jupiter
- SR 710/Beeline Highway in West Palm Beach
- SR786/PGA Boulevard in Palm Beach Gardens
- SR 715/Bacom Point Road in Pahokee
- SR 80 in Belle Glade
- SR 704/Okeechobee Boulevard from Royal Palm Beach to West Palm Beach
- SR 80/Southern Boulevard in Loxahatchee
- SR 7/US 441 from Boca Raton to Lake Worth Beach

Broward County

- Eastbound and Westbound SR 84 in Davie
- SR 823/Flamingo Road in Davie
- SR 84/Marina Mile in Fort Lauderdale
- SR 5 in Fort Lauderdale
