### **Project Overview**

#### Repave the roadway

Upgrade curb ramps to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

Upgrade pedestrian signals at 7 Avenue N., 10 Avenue N., and 13 Avenue N. to countdown signals

Install Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) and crosswalks at the north side of 6 Avenue N.

Install raised intersection at 16 Avenue N.

Install speed feedback signs near the curves at Wellesley Drive

Retrofit lighting at pedestrian crosswalks at signalized intersections

Upgrade signage and pavement markings







### **Americans with Disabilities Act Curb Ramps**





- Non-compliant and damaged curb ramps will be upgraded along the existing sidewalk.
- High emphasis pedestrian crosswalks will be added to all signalized intersections.



### **Lighting and Signalization Improvements**




Lighting retrofits at existing signalized intersections to improve visibility.

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the impacts to the community
- Temporary lane closures will be required
- Pedestrian traffic will be maintained
- Access to properties along the corridor will be maintained at all times

**Construction Cost Estimate:** \$1.6 million


