SR 729/State Market Road to Undergo Full Closure for Road Construction, August 26 — December 24, 2024

ROAD CONSTRUCTION WORK ON SR 729/STATE MARKET ROAD FROM LARRIMORE ROAD TO SR 15/E MAIN STREET

- Beginning 12:01 a.m., Monday morning, Aug. 26, SR 729/State Market Road from Larrimore Road to SR 15/E Main Street will be closed, around-the-clock, through approximately 5 p.m., Tuesday, December 24, 2024, for road construction work
- Northbound SR 729/State Market Road will be detoured via S. Lake Avenue and SR 15/E Main Street
- Southbound SR 729/State Market Road will be detoured via SR 15/E Main Street and S. Lake Avenue
- Local traffic access for emergency vehicles, residents and businesses will be maintained

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Mill and resurface SR 729/State Market Road
- Widen traffic lanes from 11 feet to 12 feet
- Widen the existing paved shoulders as permitted by FDOT right-of-way
- Reconstruct northbound SR 729/State Market Road sidewalks and shared use paths from north of Rock Pit Road to SR 15/US 441/E Main Street
- Upgrade signage and pavement markings throughout project limits
