I-95 Northbound Sound Wall Extension Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, is pleased to provide information for the sound wall extension project from south of Diane Drive to north of Diane Drive in the cities of Boynton Beach and Delray Beach.

Construction Cost: \$1,568,561 Construction Start: August 10, 2020 Anticipated Completion: Spring 2021

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Work includes extending the existing sound wall along Diane Drive approximately 500 feet to the north and south
- Removing the existing fence behind the new noise wall
- Placing sod along the new sound wall
- Performing utility adjustments

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Daytime work is permitted between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4 p.m., Monday through Saturday.
- Lane closures on I-95 are permitted nightly, 9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. One lane of I-95 may close at 9 p.m. and two lanes may close at 10 p.m., until 5 a.m.
