

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures may occur in each direction, nightly,
 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic control officers will be onsite to direct traffic as needed.
- Partial intersection closures with minor detours will occur at Quadrille Boulevard & Hibiscus Street in West Palm Beach, and Alternate A1A & Hood Road in Palm Beach Gardens.
- Simultaneous lane closures are not permitted on Hood Road at both Military Trail and Alternate A1A.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
