ROAD IMPROVEMENT WORK AT THE INTERSECTION OF LARRIMORE ROAD AND SR 729/STATE MARKET ROAD

- Larrimore Road at SR 729/State Market Road, will be closed to traffic overnight, from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday, Sept. 10 and Monday, Sept. 11 for road improvement work. In the event of unexpected delays, we will give advance notice of alternative dates.
- Motorists traveling eastbound on Larrimore Road towards SR 729/State Market Road will be detoured along northbound SR 15/Main Street to southbound SR 729/State Market Road.
- Motorists traveling along northbound and southbound SR 729/State Market Road will be detoured along SR 15/US 98/S Lake Ave/N Main Street through the City of Pahokee as noted in the detour map provided.
- Emergency access will be maintained at all times.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

 Mill and resurface the pavement, install signage, pavement markings, and sod, and perform utility adjustments at 13 railroad crossings in Palm Beach and Martin Counties.
