US 1 BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Construction Open House both in person and virtually regarding bridge and roadway improvements on US 1 from CR A1A to CR 707 and upgrading surrounding intersections in the Town of Jupiter. Participants may attend in person or online. Representatives will be available to provide information and answer questions. Project documents will be available at the meeting and at the project website fdot.gov/projects/jupiterus1bridge/main.

Construction Cost: \$122 million Construction Start Date: September 25, 2021 Anticipated Completion: 2026

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Replacing the US 1 Bridge (Bridge No. 930562) over the Loxahatchee River, including bike lanes and sidewalks in each direction
- Installing Intelligent Transportation System technology to improve traffic flow
- Adding decorative lighting and drainage
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings
- Making minor repairs to the Alternate A1A bridge (Bridge No. 930339) over the Loxahatchee River
- Improving traffic operations at Alternate A1A and Old Dixie Highway by shifting the intersection to the southwest, adding a traffic signal and lengthening the left-turn lane from northbound Alternate A1A to northbound Old Dixie Highway

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- A full bridge closure will occur for approximately 20 months beginning in Spring 2023 with traffic detoured to Alternate A1A.
- The following temporary intersection improvements will occur to improve traffic flow during construction: U.S. 1 and Indiantown Road, Alternate A1A and Indiantown Road, and Alternate A1A (Beach Road) and U.S. 1.
- One lane may be closed, one direction at a time, from 9:30 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Sunday through Saturday on U.S. 1, Indiantown Road, Alternate A1A, Old Dixie Highway and Beach Road.
- Access to adjacent properties will be maintained.
- Navigation through the channel will be maintained for marine traffic. Channel restrictions may occur.

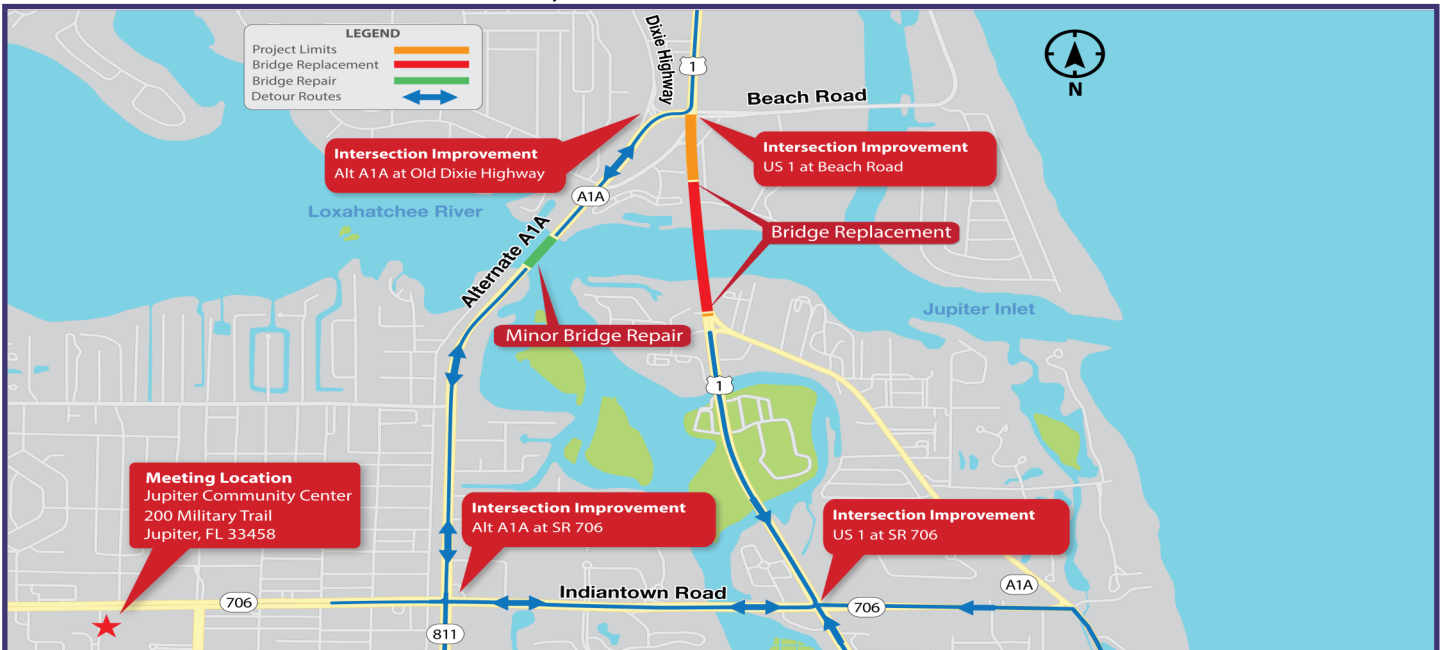
