Project Overview

Project Length: Approximately 1.599 miles

Proposed Improvements:

- Repaving the existing roadway from E. Linton Boulevard to Casuarina Road (existing pavement from Casuarina Road to E. Atlantic Avenue is in good condition)
- Upgrading pedestrian lighting at:
 - Linton Boulevard, Casuarina Road and E. Atlantic Avenue signalized intersections
 - Midblock crossings



Project Overview

Proposed Improvements (Cont.):

- Upgrading Casuarina Road pedestrian signal features for ADA compliance
- Upgrading 4 midblock crossings to Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons












Construction Impacts



Construction Impacts

- Work will be performed primarily during daytime hours
- Flagging Operations will be used to direct one lane of traffic at a time
- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community
- Access to properties adjacent to the corridor will be maintained throughout construction



Construction Impacts



Example of roadway paving



Closures/Detours:

- Limited lane closures (*one direction at a time*) will occur during paving operations
 - o Daytime in residential area

• Flagger Operation

- Sidewalk closures will occur; however, pedestrians will be detoured to always maintain sidewalk connectivity
- Shoulder closures will occur for the signalization and mid-block crossing work (*one direction at a time*)
 - During this time, bicycle traffic will be maintained on the road using shared lane markings
 - Closures and detours will be clearly delineated

What to Expect During Construction







Speed:

Existing 30 and 35 Mile Per Hour (MPH) limit will remain

Project Phasing:

Work will be done in phases to reduce the impacts of construction in the community





The contractor will be required to water and sweep in order to minimize construction-related dust



□ Estimated Construction Cost: \$2.15 million




