WESTBOUND SR 704/OKEECHOBEE BOULEVARD TO SOUTHBOUND SR 9/I-95 BRIDGE REHABILITATION AND PAINTING PROJECT

Located in the City of West Palm Beach, this 0.17-mile project consists of painting the steel and concrete portions of the bridge ramp (Bridge No. 930469) connecting westbound Okeechobee Boulevard to southbound I-95. Improvements also include minor repairs to the bridge's drainage system.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

Please see below anticipated work (weather permitting) through Oct. 15:

- Painting the steel and concrete portions of the I-95 southbound entrance ramp over I-95

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Three I-95 northbound inside lanes may be closed nightly at Okeechobee Boulevard, Sunday through Thursday. Two lanes will close at 9 p.m., and the third lane will close at 11:30 p.m. All lanes will open at 5 a.m.
- Two I-95 northbound outside lanes and the northbound I-95 entrance ramp from eastbound Okeechobee Boulevard may be closed nightly from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Oct. 6 through Oct. 8 and Oct. 11 to Oct. 15. Ramp traffic will be detoured to the northbound I-95 entrance ramp from westbound Okeechobee Boulevard via a U-Turn at Tamarind Avenue/Parker Avenue. Please see detour below.
- I-95 northbound inside and outside lanes will not be closed simultaneously.

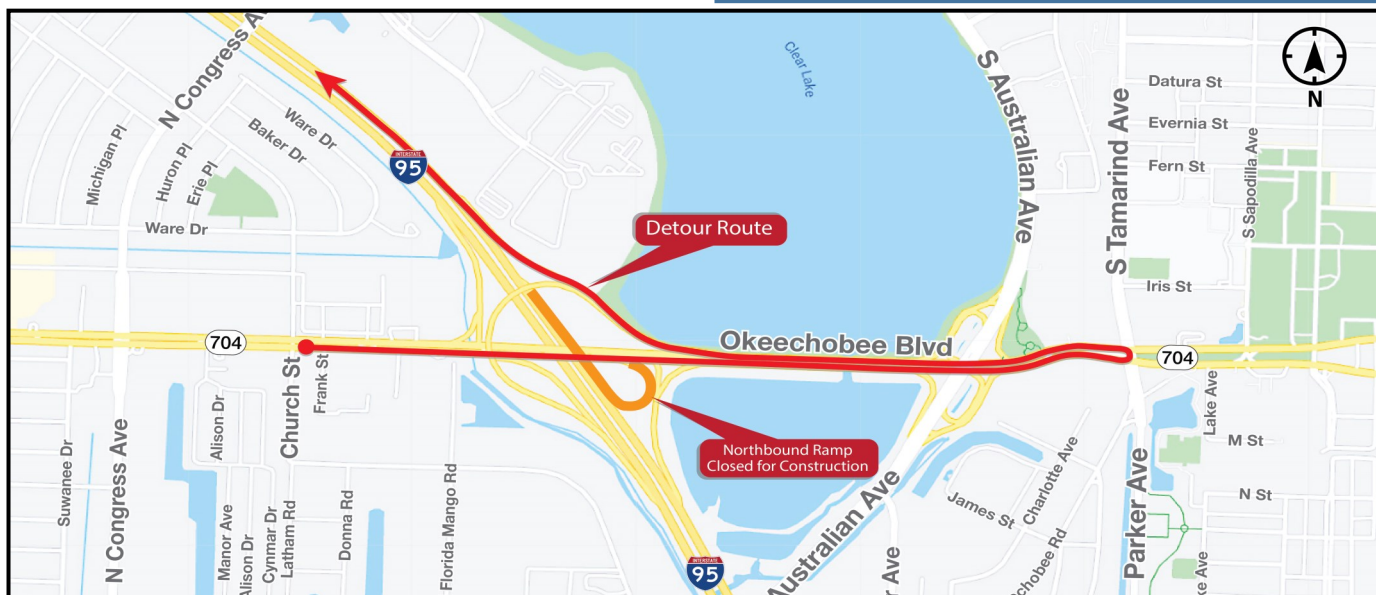
