SR 786/PGA Boulevard Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites the community to a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming SR 786/PGA Boulevard Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation Project in the City of Palm Beach Gardens. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our community. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$4.9 Million Construction Start: October 2024 Estimated Completion: Summer 2025

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Mill and repave the existing roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term resilience
- Install pedestrian signals, pavement markings, and signs to enhance safety for pedestrians and motorists
- Install green dedicated bike lane markings in each direction of SR 786/PGA Boulevard throughout the project limits to improve bicyclist safety
- Install an advanced warning flasher facing eastbound traffic approaching the Lake Victoria Gardens Avenue signalized intersection to enhance motorist safety
- Upgrade traffic signal vehicle video detection and traffic controller cabinets to improve traffic flow
- Reconstruct the concrete bus pad at Fairchild Gardens
 Avenue to enhance transit rider safety and accessibility
- Reconstruct pedestrian sidewalk curb ramps to meet current Americans with Disability Act (ADA) standards

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Work will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public
- Single eastbound lane closures on SR 786/PGA Boulevard are allowed from 9:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday nights
- Single westbound lane closures on SR 786/PGA Boulevard are allowed from 11:00 p.m. until 9:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday nights
- Double eastbound lane closures on SR 786/PGA Boulevard are allowed from 11:00 p.m. until 6:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday nights
- Double westbound lane closures on SR 786/PGA Boulevard are allowed from 11:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday nights
- Intermittent single-lane closures will occur on Lake Victoria Gardens Avenue nightly as needed
- Pedestrian detours will be provided during pedestrian curb ramp closures
- Access to northbound and southbound SR 9/I-95 on-ramps, businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
