BRIDGE TO REOPEN OCTOBER 8

The SR A1A/Haven Ashe Bridge over the Boca Raton Inlet will reopen to vehicle and pedestrian traffic at approximately noon on Thursday, October 8. Normal bridge operations have resumed with on-demand openings for marine vessels. Painting operations are anticipated to continue through the month of October.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- This project in the city of Boca Raton consists of painting the steel and concrete portions of the State Road A1A/Haven Ashe Bridge over the Boca Raton Inlet (Bridge No. 930060).

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Intermittent sidewalk closures may occur. Northbound and southbound sidewalks will not be closed simultaneously.
- Marine traffic will be maintained through the navigable waterway.
