SR 9/I-95 Northbound Off-Ramp at Indiantown Road Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming SR 9/I-95 Northbound Off-Ramp at SR 706/Indiantown Road Improvements Project in the Town of Jupiter. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$17.98 million

Construction Start: October 2023

Estimated Completion: Spring 2025

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Mill and resurface existing roadway
- Re-align the SR 9/I-95 northbound to SR 706/Indiantown Road eastbound off-ramp to a new signalized intersection
- Lengthen the eastbound SR 706/Indiantown Road left turn lane to northbound SR 9/I-95
- Widen eastbound SR 706/Indiantown Road to provide an additional through lane and a buffered bike lane in various locations from the Florida Turnpike entrance to Central Boulevard
- Widen westbound SR 706/Indiantown Road to provide an additional through lane and a bike lane from 67th Road North to SR 9/I-95
- Widen the Indiantown Road Bridge over C-18 canal in both directions to provide an additional through lane
- Upgrade Wrong-Way Driving Countermeasures on the SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound exit ramps
- Upgrade Dynamic Message Sign (DMS) structures on westbound SR 706/Indiantown Road between Island Way and 67th Road North
- Widen the SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound on-ramp acceleration lanes
- Install sidewalk along eastbound SR 706/Indiantown Road from the Florida Turnpike entrance to Island Way
- Upgrade curb ramps to meet Americans with Disability Act (ADA) standards
- Install patterned pavement crosswalks at Central Boulevard
- Upgrade drainage, signage, lighting, signalization and pavement markings
- Upgrade Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) throughout the project corridor

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single-lane closures on SR 706/Indiantown Road are permitted nightly, 9:00 p.m. until 6:30 a.m., Sunday through Friday and double-lane closures are permitted nightly, 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Friday
- Single-lane closures on Island Way are permitted nightly, 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Friday
- Ramp closures will take place as needed, nightly, 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Notice of detours will be provided in advance. Closures of SR 9/I-95 off and on ramps will not occur simultaneously
- To minimize impact to the public, work will be performed in phases. Access to business, driveways and pedestrians will be maintained at all times
