WESTBOUND SR 704/OKEECHOBEE BOULEVARD TO SOUTHBOUND SR 9/I-95 BRIDGE REHABILITATION AND PAINTING PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four is pleased to provide information regarding the routine maintenance and repair of the ramp connecting westbound Okeechobee Boulevard to southbound I-95 in the City of West Palm Beach.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Painting the steel and concrete portions of the bridge ramp (Bridge No. 930469) connecting westbound Okeechobee Boulevard to I-95
- Conducting minor repairs to the bridge drainage system

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- I-95 mainline lane closures and full northbound and southbound on-ramp closures may occur from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.
- Lane closures may occur on Okeechobee Boulevard from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Sunday through Thursday.
- Detours will be provided during full ramp closures to direct motorists to I-95 on-ramps via U-turns at Church Street and Parker Avenue.
- Pedestrian detours will be in place during sidewalk and bike lane closures on Okeechobee Boulevard.
- Access to residences and businesses will be maintained at all times.
