Okeechobee Boulevard South Sidewalk to Close Sunday Night, Nov. 8 Through Spring 2022

To ensure pedestrian safety, the south sidewalk along Okeechobee Boulevard will be closed beginning Sunday night, Nov. 8 through spring 2022, so crews can safely widen eastbound Okeechobee Boulevard to accommodate a future exclusive turn lane onto I-95 southbound. During this operation, pedestrians will be detoured to the north sidewalk via Church Street and Tamarind Avenue. Signage will be in place to assist pedestrians.
