NIGHTTIME RAMP CLOSURES FOR PAVING OPERATIONS

- The **northbound on and off ramps** at Florida's Turnpike at Boynton Beach Boulevard will be closed, **9 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday night, Dec. 1**, for paving operations
 - Should inclement weather delay operations, work will take place the following night
- **Motorists traveling northbound on Florida's Turnpike may exit at Atlantic Avenue, west to SR 7/US 441 and north to Boynton Beach Boulevard**
- **Motorists traveling on Boynton Beach Boulevard may detour west to SR 7/US 441, north to Lake Worth Road, and east to Florida's Turnpike**
- First responder access will be maintained at all times

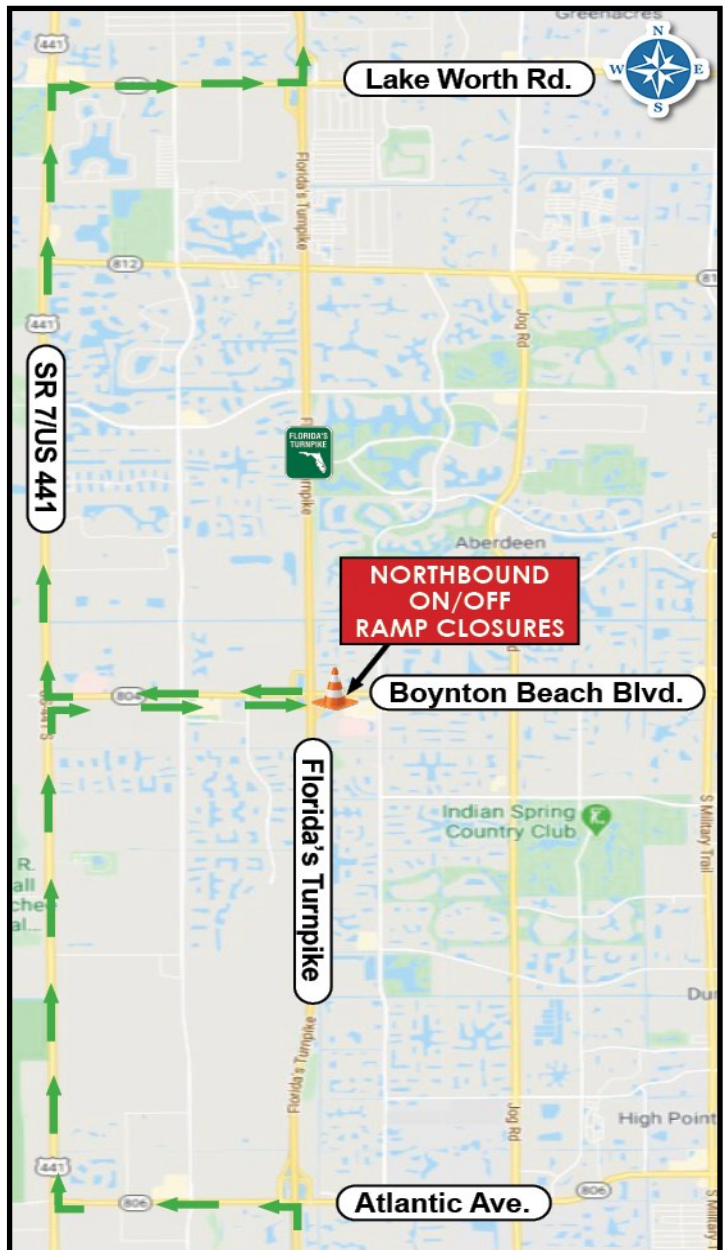
