### NORTHBOUND & SOUTHBOUND SEACREST BOULEVARD AT SR 804/BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD TO CLOSE DEC. 8-10, 2024

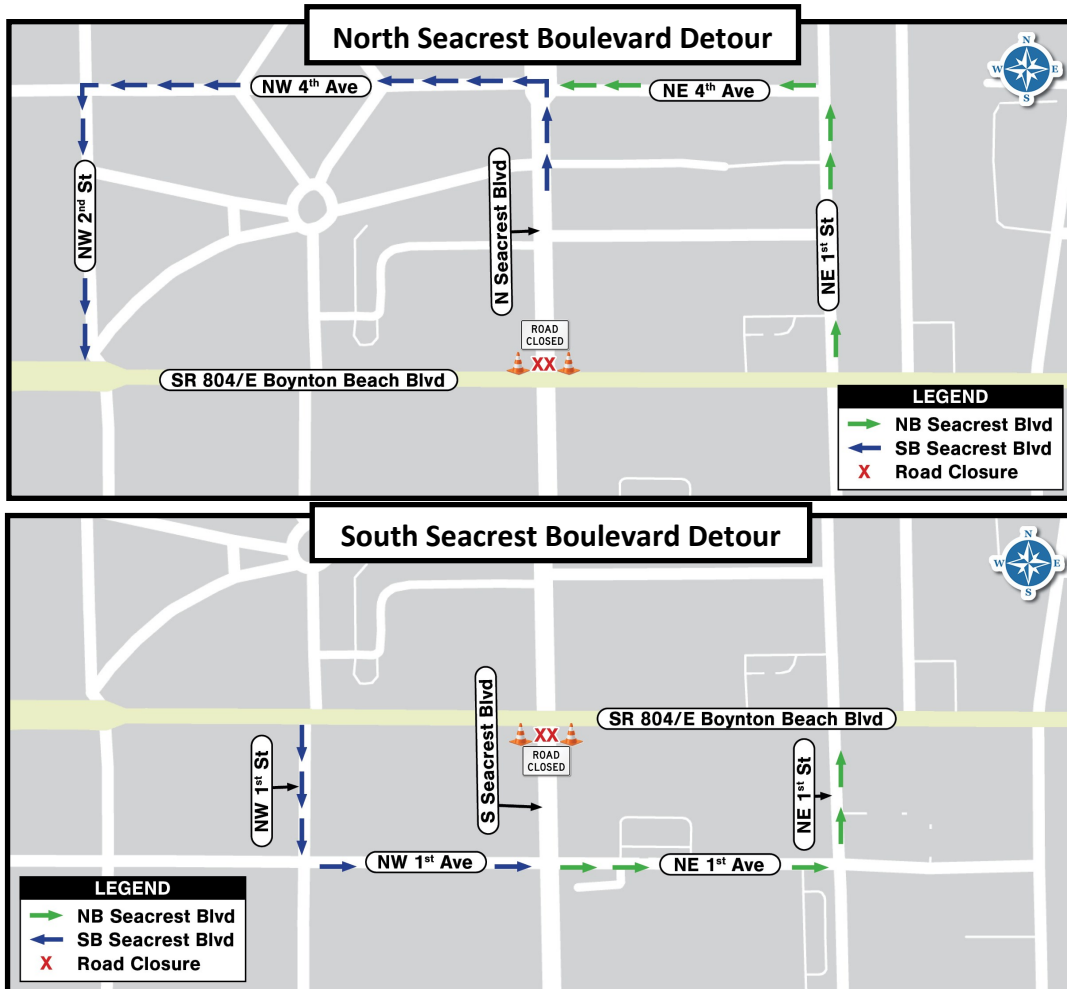
To ensure public safety, northbound and southbound Seacrest Boulevard at SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, Dec. 8, through Tuesday, Dec. 10, for roadway construction activities. Wednesday, Dec. 11, through Friday, Dec. 13, will be used as contingency nights, if needed. First responder access will be maintained at all times during this operation. Signage will be in place to assist motorists

#### Northbound Seacrest Boulevard Detours:

- Traffic from SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard will be detoured northbound via NE 1<sup>st</sup> Street to NE 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- Motorists traveling to SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard will be detoured via NW 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue to NW 2<sup>nd</sup> Street.

#### Southbound Seacrest Boulevard Detours:

- Traffic from SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard will be detoured via NW 1<sup>st</sup> Street to NE 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue.
- Motorists traveling to SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard will be detoured via NE 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue to NE 1<sup>st</sup> Street.



### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling, resurfacing and reconstructing SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard within project limits
- Expanding the existing sidewalk on the south side of SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard to 15 feet and to 9 feet on the north side
- Performing drainage modifications to accommodate sidewalk expansion on SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard
- Retrofitting pedestrian lighting at signalized intersections on SR/804 Boynton Beach Boulevard
- Constructing a new pedestrian crossing at NW 3rd Street and SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard
- Installing shared lane bicycle markings (sharrows) in each direction of SR 804/Boynton Beach Boulevard and on West Ocean Avenue
- Upgrading pedestrian signals, pavement markings, and signs
